THINGS TO REMEMBER:

- Set your page size to A4 on PowerPoint before you start
- Your font size should be 14 for the main body of text and 18/20 for any titles.
- Your work will be check throughout the project so that you are getting regular feedback.
- If it is deemed, you are falling behind in your work then you will be required to attend extra sessions to catch up.
- Extra sessions are open to everybody and usually run until 430pm Monday -Thursday and till 4pm on Fridays in required.
- Make sure you talk to your teacher and express any difficulties you may be having as well as your successes. We are here to support you through this; the good and the bad!
- Never delete anything and store your images in an orderly fashion so that you can find them easily if you need them later on down the line.
- The more images you take the better off you will be. A shoot MUST have at least 30 photographs.
- You will be marked on language so make sure that are not only using the correct terminology but writing in full and fluid sentences and keep an eye on your spelling, punctuation and grammar.
- Be creative; remember that this is a creative arts course... try and be as creative as you can and ask if you need assistance.
- Think outside the box... You shouldn't just copy the work of artists but use them to inspire you and your work.
- BE BRAVE!!
