





I will try to focus more on people who look as though they are going somewhere, on a journey or people who look as though there could be a story behind them.


I will take into account the backgrounds of the images more now, and what I can try and include to make my photographs more striking.

Improvements from last London shoot

I will focus on the angles in which I am going to take my photographs as I feel like this is a very important factor in creating a good photo. I will make sure everything that I want is in the frame and I shoot it in the angle that portrays the images in the best way.

I will take more time with my editing, making sure that the black and white that I convert the pictures to are perfect and have the right contrast and the right brightness to them, not being too dark, or too light.

F-stop: f/3.8 Exposure time: 1/1600 sec. ISO speed: ISO-1600

These image, like the other ones, I think look a lot better in black and white, having a better sense of documentary and of a journey. 

F-stop: f/2.2 Exposure time: 1/33 sec. ISO speed: ISO-160

I will photograph the person sitting opposite me, or people who are around me. I will do this subtly and have my camera on my lap, or on the chair between my legs and I will take pictures of anything and everything I can. I plan to do the same on trains.









These are some of my edited images













This image is different from most of my other pictures because it doesn't focus on just one person, but more then one. This gives the image more character and makes it more interesting as there is more to look at. It looks as though it is quite chaotic, however it works in this case.

The diversity of people n this frame gives the image individuality. They are all different and are all doing different things. One persons sleeping, another ones listening to music, some are reading and this could show things about the person and their personality.

This line on the floor, with their shoes crossing it gives the image a sense of order within quite a chaotic frame. My eye gets drawn here as the image is very busy. And then you have this break, being able to see the floor and the line which runs parallel to the chair. This also allows you to see people shoes and I think that you can tell a lot from a person by looking at their shoes.

The way in which I have taken this picture is perfect as it is straight but because of the way the tubes are, it looks almost as though I have taken the photo on an angle, which I have not. This creates some kind of illusion like effect on the person who is looking at this picture. This could mean that the viewers linger and loo at the image for longer.

I took this picture as when I was standing up I saw the line of people sitting down, each of them doing different things for example reading the newspaper, and I thought that the structure of this photograph worked very well and was interesting. This image is one of my photographs from my shoot, photographing people on tubes. This shoot went very well and thoroughly enjoyed doing it. The pictures I captured are all very individual standing out from one another. If I were to do this shoot I would do everything the same however I would take more and more pictures as I find them fascinating to look at.
